

HOLIDAY SCAVENGER HUNT GAME

Place value



How to play

The players take one scavenger card each. They use a deck of number cards 0-10. At their turn, they pick two cards and they use one for the tens and one for the ones. They form a number. If they use the number 10 for tens, their tens form a 100. For example, using 10 for tens and 6 for ones becomes 106. Since number is more than 100, they start over. For example, if they form 106, they get the picture of number 6. If they use the number 10 for ones then the ones become a ten and the ones 0. (regrouping) 5 for tens and 10 for ones becomes 60.

Once they form a number they find it on the table. The numbers hide a picture. They mark that picture on their scavenger card. The first player to mark all the pictures on their card is the winner. The players try to form a number that helps them get the picture they need.
